

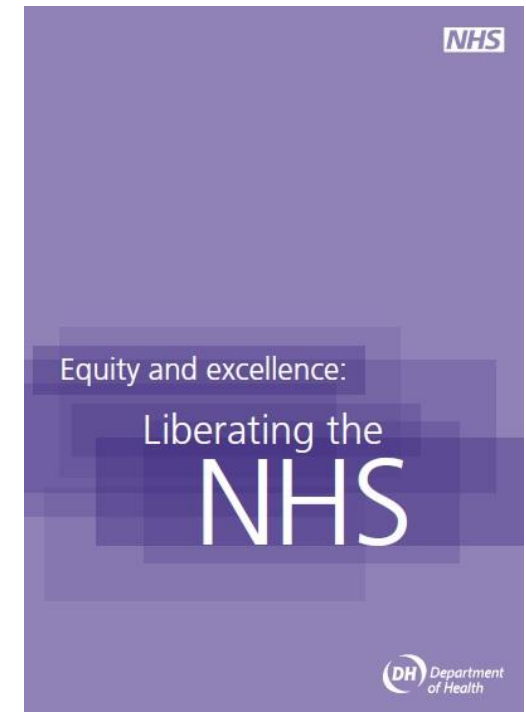
WHAT IS HAPPENING IN THE NORTH EAST?

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Equity and excellence: Liberating the NHS (White Paper)

- Putting patients and public first;
- Improving healthcare outcomes;
- Autonomy, accountability and democratic legitimacy;

Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG)

- A CCG is a group of GPs and other clinicians who will commission health services for their local community;
- CCGs will be responsible for commissioning NHS services that were previously commissioned by the PCT;
- CCGs will also commission hospital services, community services and mental health/learning disability services;
- Currently 20 pathfinder consortium in north east;



Learning Disability Self Assessment Framework

- Completed annual all over England;
- Currently completing it for the 4th year in the north east;
- Self assessment identifies current practice and improvement actions;



4 Top Targets



- People who are or who were formerly in NHS provided long term care have settled accommodation that reflects their person centred plans;
- Commissioners are working closely with local Boards, statutory and other partners to address health inequalities faced by people with learning disabilities;
- People with learning disabilities who are in services that the NHS commissions or provides are safe;
- Progress is being made in developing local services for those needing more help to be healthy;
