What's it all about?

Inclusion North is offering free training to its members on how to use the Stop Hate Crime Learning Together training pack.

The training is for self advocates on how to use the Hate Crime Learning Together Pack to help stop hate crime happening where they live This might be training other people with learning disabilities, the police or children and young people in school.

It will help you work out what changes need to be made where you live and how you can make them happen together.



Who will run the training and how long will it last?

A team of people with learning disabilities from different groups and organisations will be running the training.

They will be using the Stop Hate Crime Learning Together training pack and the things they know from the work they have done already on Hate Crime.



The training is a one day session.
Inclusion North can offer more support after the training to people that would like it.

When & where is it happening?

The trainers will come to you at a local venue, on a day that suits you. Just get in touch with us to arrange a day and time.

How much is it?

The training is free to Inclusion North members and you don't have to spend your vouchers to pay for it.
