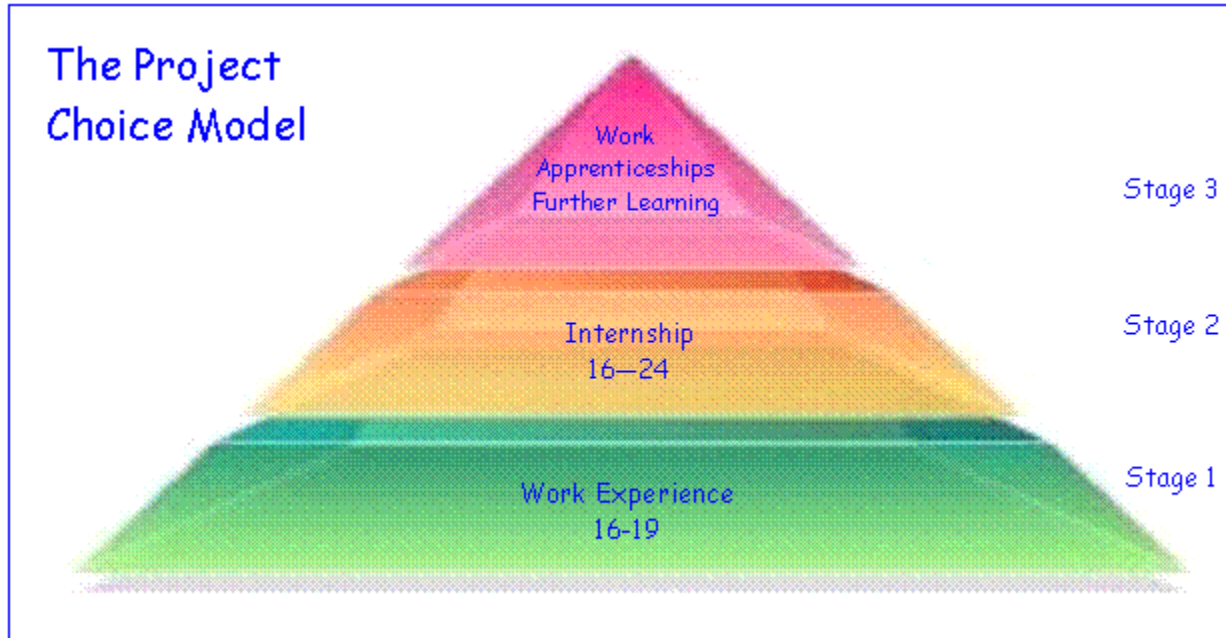


# Project Choice

# Stage One Work Experience



## How we do it

- 16-24 year olds -6 week placement.
- One morning a week.
- Work as part of a team with a Mentor.



## The students learn

- Understanding of the world of work
- Opportunity to try several placements find out what they like and don't like

# Stage Two Internship



- 1 academic year in length.
- 4 days in work placement.
- 1 day in college.
  
- Opportunity to have up to 3 different work placements

# Work Placements



- Matched to student.
- We support all the interns.
- We train the staff on how to help a person with learning disabilities learn to work.



All of the learning is reinforced in the classroom.

- All the interns undertake a qualification

put the linen away

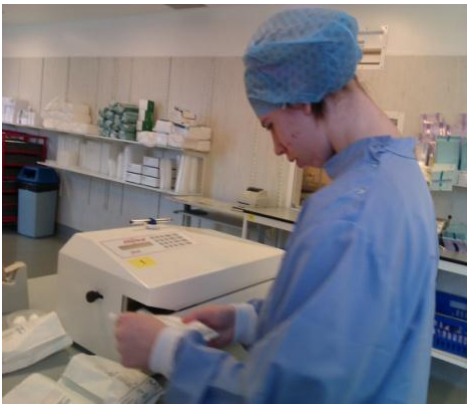
Made beds for patients
